## TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, it is proposed to temporarily close the following public roads to facilitate the Winterval Festival 2015.

1. From 6am Sunday 16th November 2015 until 6am Monday 4th January 2016 the following street will be closed for the Winterval Christmas Market:

Arundel Square - L5532 (from its junction with Peter Street to Conduit lane).
