



DERELICT SITES ACT, 1990

NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF A VESTING ORDER

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN that Waterford City & County Council (hereinafter called “the Council”) has pursuant to the powers vested in it by Section 15 and Section 17 of the Derelict Sites Act 1990, on the 11th day of September 2015 made a Vesting Order whereby the lands specified in the Schedule hereto (being a Derelict Site within Section 3 of the Derelict Site Act 1990) will on the 2nd day of October 2015 VEST in the Council in fee simple free from encumbrances and all estate rights titles and interests of whatsoever kind.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that a map of the said Derelict Site and a copy of the said Vesting Order have been deposited in the Offices of the Council and may be seen between 9.30 a.m. – 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. - 4 p.m., Monday to Friday at: Customer Services Dept, Baileys New Street, Waterford and at the Planning Office, Civic Offices, Dungarvan.

ALL THAT AND THOSE the property known as 3 Mill Row, Curtiswood, Ballymacarbry in the County of Waterford comprising an area of 0.03 acres or thereabouts statute measure in the District Electoral Division of Comeragh more particularly shown and delineated on Map Ref. No. 1.

PLEASE NOTE that any person who immediately before the making of the above Order has any estate or interest in respect of the Derelict Site acquired may apply to the Council, not later than 12 months after the making of the Order, for compensation in respect of their estate, interest or right.
